DIRECTIONS: From Logan International Airport to Quality Inn & Suites

The best and cheapest way is to take the Silver line trolley from the Airport to the South Station.

1. **At Logan Airport**, you will take the Silver line trolley to **South Station**. You will pay \$2.00 when getting on the trolley at the airport. When getting off the trolley at South Station, you will NOT have to pay anything to take the Red Line subway inbound (in the direction to Alewife) to **Davis Square**.
2. At station **Davis Square**, after the escalator on the first level right above the train, take a left to 94 and 96 bus stop. From here you will take several more escalators to the ground, since it is deep underground.
3. Getting out of the escalator on the ground, you will go straight ahead to the street, which is **College Avenue**. You will stay here and give Dr. Binh Ngo a call at his cell phone [617-233-5391](tel:617-233-5391), and he will pick you up. How long will it take him to drive to Davis Square depends on whether he will be at that moment, and, of course, on the traffic, which may be terrible in the Boston area at rush hour. Please do not call him at my office or home number on Wednesday. He will be driving back and forth all the time on that day.

Those of you who will be flying into Boston next Wednesday and want Dr. Binh Ngo to pick you up at the subway station and to drive you to the hotel, please let him know the time of your arrival so he will arrange his time on that day.
