Possible answers

1.
 - a. to move oneself to techno music
 - b. to move oneself using a dog-team
 - c. to use a Harley
 - d. to put a band-aid on a cut
 - etc.
2. to kindle, to pdf, to 202: to Salvation-army

She kindled Moby Dick;
I pdf-ed my paper;
Zelda 202ed to the Airport;
They Salvation-armed the clothes;
3. b, e, f seem possible:
ok to me: frall, sproke, flube,
not ok: mbood, coofp, ktleem, wordms, bsarn
4. ...
5. c, d, f, h (perhaps g) are possible; the others have parts missing, the wrong reflexives, strange phrasal verbs, etc.
6. Note: Most of these are acceptable except in the most formal registers:
 - a. agreement
 - b. agreement
 - c. agreement
 - d. past participle form is not the past tense
 - e. Case and contraction
 - f. Case and preposition stranding
 - g. using the participle for the past; or 'have' left out
 - h. same
 - i. 'to be' left out; or use of -ing rather than the infinitive
 - j. 'aint' and negative concord (or double negation)
 - k. antecedent is singular but pronoun is plural
 - l. variant (regularized) reflexive form.

Linguists would say these are fine!
